To whom it may concern

This is to confirm that Michał Sawicki vel Mosze Iglicki, son of Abraham Mejer Iglicki and Fajga Chuma nee Cichowska, born in Kołbiel on 10 October 1893 is Jewish.

Based on government-issued documentation, published sources and documents held in the Jewish Historical Institute Archives, we confirm that:

- he was born in Kołbiel, Poland to Jewish parents: Abram Majer Iglicki and Fajga Chuma Cichowska,
- he registered after the war with the Central Committee of Jews in Poland as Mosze Iglicki, born on 10 October 1893 in Kołbiel – registration in Warsaw in 1945;
- he changed his name and given name from Mosze Iglicki to Michał Sawicki on 9 January 1957, as many others, who stayed in Poland after the war.
- he never changed the names of his parents:
his marriage certificate I-Star.-105/1957 (marriage on 16 February 1957 in Łódź) and his death certificate I-57/1959 (death on 26 February 1959 in Łódź) list Abram Majer Iglicki and Fajga Chuma Cichowska as the parents.

There is no doubt that Moszek Iglicki, born on 10 October 1893 in Kołbiel to Abram Majer Iglicki and Fajga Chuma Cichowska is Michał Sawicki, born in Kołbiel on 10 October 1893 to Abram Majer Iglicki and Fajga Chuma Cichowska. The change of name is clearly indicated in an official Polish document.
